# Dear Fellow Knitters and Crocheters,

With the delay in the start of Spring, we've had a little extra time to finish up our winter projects. I hope you've taken advantage and now are ready for a fun new spring project. Just last week we started putting out our new spring yarns. It's nice to see all the brighter colors and lighter fibers.

We do have three new chunkier yarns with great pattern support, so a new spring sweater can be a quick knit. Rowan's All Seasons Cotton Chunky, Berroco's Karma and Classic Elite's Sprout all have designs that feature a variety of open stitch work. They're perfect for the beginner or intermediate knitter. I am working up samples in each of these yarns so be sure to come in and check them out.

Tahki Stacy Charles has a delicate new cotton yarn with sequins called Flora. Designs for this yarn include a lace patterned cardigan and a striped pullover. Both are elegant. Ripple, another Tahki with a fabulous texture that makes stockinette look like an involved pattern, can be knit up into a charming vest with a ruffle collar.

Shibui's Linen with it's chainette construction is getting a lot of attention too. I've knit up a striped scarf (Did I mention stripes are big this spring?) using a fun assortment of colors. My sample is a free pattern off the Shibui Knits website.

The yarn fairies do continue to do their magic with a variety of fiber combinations. The spring fiber of choice appears to be linen. Handmaiden has Flaxen, a wonderful silk and linen blend. Trendsetter has Twiggy with a fun spikey texture, a mix of linen and viscose. Queensland has hand-dyed Pima Linen (cotton and linen) and Tristan, another viscose and linen combo. Isager's Plant Fiber is comprised of ramie, bamboo and hemp and Classic Elite's Soft Linen is a mix of linen and alpaca. Clearly the yarn industry is expanding the warm weather options for knitting.

New in our line-up of summer classes is a knitting camp for moms. Linda is working up a great selection of projects for the camp. Games and prizes are also in the offering.

Don't miss our 11<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Sale which will run from Wednesday, April 3 – Saturday, April 6. It is sure to be chock full of great deals as I try to trim our inventory!
