We're getting very excited for the upcoming fall season and we have a great line-up of classes for you to choose from. At the moment, we're getting prepared for the Chicago Yarn Crawl which marks the beginning of our displaying new fall yarns and samples. The Yarn Crawl runs from July 29-August 6. We will be hosting an Isager Open House on August 2, from 7-9 p.m. Last year we had a great response to this event. Please rsvp if you plan on coming.

Adrienne and I recently returned from Tversted, Denmark, the home of Isager yarns, where we saw their new fall collection. Seeing all of Marianne and Helga Isager's design samples along with their full selection of yarns was very inspiring. We knit swatches of the various stitches to familiarize us with their new patterns. We picked flowers and plants and used them for hand-dyeing their fiber. All in all, we were able to explore more about their wonderful yarn company.

We had so much fun doing Joji Locatelli's mystery knit-along Starting Point. Now that the design has been released and our shop sample is on display, even more customers are taking on this project. As a follow-up, we will be hosting a Starting Point Celebration on Friday, August 25th from 4-6 p.m. for everyone to show off their version of Starting Point. Not done or stuck at a certain point? We want you to come too! We'll try to help you out. We had close to 100 customers joining in on this knit-along.

Early arrivals for fall are many hand-dyed fibers from Madelinetosh, Baah yarns and Sweet Georgia. Already on the shelves is Blue Sky Alpaca's Techno, a fluffy light alpaca. Jill should have the Preston Pullover shop sample, using Techno, done and on display by the time this newsletter arrives. Cumbria Fingering is also here. Melanie Berg has designed several shawls, Ingwer and Tamdou, that were knit up in Cumbria Fingering. Kelbourne Woolens also used this yarn for a number of their mitten patterns in their Year of the Mitten Collection.

Coming soon... Rowan seems to be back in force. The new Rowan Magazine No. 62 is full of great new designs. Look for Rowan Cashmere Tweed. Berroco's new Quechua, a wool/alpaca/yak blend is great for lace and stitch patterns. Lang's Passione is a luxurious baby alpaca with some great pattern support.

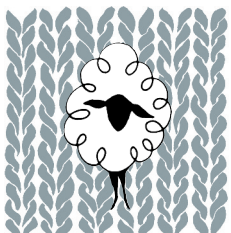
