Dear Fellow Knitters and Crocheters,

It seems too early to be thinking fall and classes, but with the end of our spring-summer session two weeks away, we're already hearing from you that you want to know what's coming.

For the first time in four years, we'll be offering a Knitting Camp for Kids shortly before school starts. The week of August 14-18, we'll meet each day from 1:30 – 3 p.m. We have seen a growing amount of interest among our young customers. We recommend kids be 8 and above to take our knitting camp. Each time we've run this camp it's been a great experience and very fun for us to see how enthusiastic the kids become about knitting.

Our fun Saturday sock workshop with Mr. Knitbear and DenDennis on their Happily Knitting World Tour was a huge hit a few weeks back and we have seen a real resurgence in creative sock knitting. They have written several sock books with all sorts of wild and wacky patterns. We've added some bright new colors and new sock lines for fall. Kelbourne Woolens' Perennial, Wool Addicts' Move and Freia yarns SoulMate offer a cheery and colorful take on socks. Our upcoming Two-at-a-Time-Toe-Up class will teach you to use the magic loop method of knitting in the round. It's a great alternative for those who would rather avoid knitting with double points. Better yet, you get both socks done at the same time!

With the H&H tradeshow being in our backyard (Rosemont), we were fortunate to have

the Isager team visit the shop at the end of June. Helga Isager presented the Botanica and Breeze collections, which were designed by a several Danish designers including Anne Ventzel and Mette Wendelboe Okkels (Petiteknits). Around the shop, Anne Ventzel is best known as the designer of the Robinia sweater. Also on display were Marianne Isager's sweaters from her book, *A Knitting Life*, the first of three books that will span Marianne's life work as a knitwear designer. If you haven't gotten a peek at this book, you really should. We were very inspired The books is on sale here in the shop.

Isager has been adding new fibers to their repertoire including Trio 2, a new linen blend, and Isager Boucle, a DK weight soft alpaca boucle. Our new shop sample of Anne Ventzel's Shore Sweater sample uses Trio 2 run with Alpaca 1. The boucle is about to arrive so we haven't played with that yet.

Now take a look inside at what classes are coming for fall. We hope to see you soon!

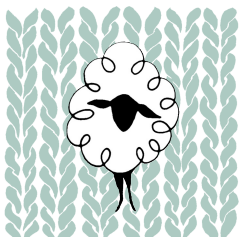
