Dear Fellow Knitters and Crocheters,

While we are getting ready for the spring and summer season, it seems as though the weather can't decide if it's quite ready to end winter. Regardless, we're moving forward.

Shibui Knits has launched their new cotton fiber Fern and I am busy knitting up their pretty new design Mirage. By the time you read this, I hope it'll be hanging in the shop. Isager yarns has a new collection of spring designs using their Bomullin (cotton) and their Japanese Cotton. We're part of a traveling trunk show that will feature a new sweater in the shop every two weeks. Be sure to ask about the current featured design when you're in the shop. Kelbourne Woolens is now distributing BC Garn fibers from Denmark and we have their Tussah Tweed, 100% Tussah silk. Lang is featuring a hemp yarn called Canapa and their magazine offers a number of patterns that call for it. Katia's Lino (yes, linen) has been popular too. Linda and Penny have both knit a "Carolina Beach" poncho using Lino and it's on display in the shop.

We have a "Fade" craze going on in the shop, be it "Find Your Fade", "What the Fade?!" shawls (both on display in the shop) or "Comfort Fade Cardi" and "So Faded" sweaters. If you haven't already gotten swept up in it, check out Drea Renee Knits or Andrea Mowry on Ravelry. Her designs involve transitioning for one color to the next, blending an array of colors. Come join the "Fade Craze"!

We have Comfort Fade Cardi Kits from Baah Yarn in stock. Nancy just finished her "So Faded" pullover, knit with Madelinetosh Twist Light and Baah LaJolla. It's a showstopper!

I can't stop talking about Andrea Mowry designs... Nancy is offering a class on her hat design, Tinture. It's a two-color, slip stitch/mosaic knitting project. Check it out!

Other classes that have us excited are Spot Cloth Sweater by Marianne Isager (Penny Theo), Crocheted Wild Animals (Suzy), and Big Baskets (Linda).

There are a few new striping and patterning sock yarns on the shelf. Don't miss out on Adrienne's Beginning Socks class or Diana's Two at a Time and Toe Up Socks class. To top it off Linda has added a Mending Socks class.

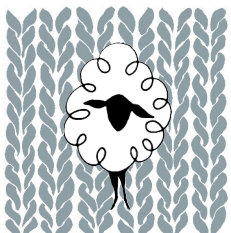
