Dear Fellow Knitters and Crocheters,

I thought I would share a little bit about my visit to Tversted, Denmark this past spring. Isager yarns invited yarn shop owners from around the world for their International Retailer's Meeting at their headquarters. Tversted is a small seaside town with a year-round population of 400. It's located at Denmark's northernmost tip on the North Sea. I visited several years ago and there's something magical about being there. There's a feeling of calm peacefulness...the simple life.

I stayed at a hotel right by the sea. In the mornings when I was setting off to attend the daily events, I would see a parade of residents marching towards the sea. They were wearing winter coats and hats and beach shoes, knowing that a bathing suit was beneath. It's a common routine for many to take a dip or swim in the chilly waters before starting their day. It seems the cold water gives them the jolt they want. It speaks for taking time for oneself

The surrounding area was a neighborhood of tidy small homes and open fields for sheep to graze or gorgeous yellow flowers to flourish. I learned the yellow fields were canola plants.

Marianne Isager is thoughtfully growing her business, the center of which is a refurbished elementary school. It serves as a community center, housing art studios for local artists, a café and the fabulous yarn shop of all of Isager yarns and designs. They utilize the school's kitchen facilities for meal preparation. Their chef takes full advantage of locally grown and heart-healthy. Meals are prepared for the center's events and can truly be a feast.

The gym serves as the event space where we were treated to a delicious dinner and fashion show. They've engaged a group of Danish

knitwear designers who come together for a design retreat under the leadership of Helga Isager. Each year a highly anticipated new collection is released.

We had a long bus ride to the woolen mill where their base fibers are produced. It's a pretty amazing process of turning fleece into yarn. During our visit Marianne had an exciting announcement that they will be moving the mill to their campus in Tversted.

When I think back about my time there this spring, I think of the other yarn shop owners who I was able to connect with, the hum of numerous foreign languages, while the common one was English. One such shop owner had come by bus from her home in Kiev. I now follow a number of these shops on Instagram and am surprised to hear (and not understand) them speak their various languages. Thank goodness Instagram offers translating.

I am left with an appreciation for this small yarn company that has chosen to stay in their community and has reached out to us to share their yarns, knitting techniques and vision of beautiful designs. It is truly a center for creativity. I was inspired.
