



STITCH AWAY SCARF

Chicago Yarn Crawl Pattern 2019

This scarf was inspired by Barbara Walker's [A Treasury of Knitting Patterns](#). There are seven different stitch patterns used in this scarf, starting out with easy and becoming more difficult. At times you may need to increase or decrease the number of stitches on your needles in order to accommodate the various stitch patterns. So, cast on and "stitch away"!

YARN: Kelbourne Woolens Germantown, 2 skeins

Needles: U.S. 8

Cast on 40 stitches and knit every row for 6 rows. The first 4 stitches and last 4 stitches are knit every row (garter stitch). You should place a marker after the 4th stitch and before the last 4 stitches to "remind" you to work these stitches in garter. The following stitch patterns are worked in between these markers.

Pattern 1: "Quaker Ridging" (40 sts)

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.

Row 9: Knit.

Row 10: Purl.

Row 11: Knit.

Row 12: Knit.

Row 13: Purl.

Row 14: Knit.

Repeat rows 1-14 until pattern 1 measures 8".

Knit 5 rows. Knit 1 more row, increasing 1 after the initial K4.

Pattern 2: "Broken Rib" (41 sts)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: (K1, P1) repeat, end with K1.

Row 4: (P1, K1) repeat, end with P1.

Repeat these 4 rows until you have worked 8" in Pattern 2.

Knit for 6 rows.

Version 3: 10/29/21019

Pattern 3: “Diamond Brocade” (41 sts)
 Row 1: K4, (P1, K7) repeat to last 5 sts. before marker, p1, k4.
 Row 2: P3, (K1, P1, K1, P5) repeat to last 6 sts before marker, K1, P1, K1, P3.
 Row 3: K2, (P1, K3) repeat to last 3 sts. before marker P1, K2.
 Row 4: P1, (K1, P5, K1, P1) repeat to marker.
 Row 5: (P1, K7) repeat to 1 st before marker, P1.
 Row 6: Same as Row 4.
 Row 7: Same as Row 3.
 Row 8: Same as Row 2.
 Repeat these 8 rows until you have worked 8” of Pattern 3.

Knit 6 rows. On the 6th row work a k2tog anywhere along the row.

Pattern 4: “Wetted Leaf Pattern” (40 sts)
 Row 1: Knit
 Row 2: Purl
 Row 3: (K4, P4) repeat.
 Row 4: K3, (P4, K4) repeat to last 5 sts before the marker, P4, K1.
 Row 5: P2, (K4, P4) repeat to last 6 sts before the marker, K4, P2.
 Row 6: K1, (P4, K4) repeat to last 7 sts before marker, P4, K3
 Row 7: Same as Row 4.
 Row 8: Same as Row 5.
 Row 9: Same as Row 6.
 Row 10: (P4, K4) repeat.
 Row 11: Knit.
 Row 12: Purl.
 Row 13: Knit.
 Row 14: Knit
 Repeat Rows 1-14 four times.

Knit 6 rows

Pattern 5: “Single Eyelet Rib” (40 sts)
 Set up row: Knit.
 Row 1 (Wrong Side): K2, (P3, K2) repeat.
 Row 2: P2, (K3, P2) repeat.
 Row 3: Same as Row 1.
 Row 4: P2, (K2tog, yo, K1, P2) repeat.
 Row 5: Same as Row 1.
 Row 6: P2, (K3, P2) repeat.
 Row 7: Same as Row 1.
 Row 8: P2, (K1, yo, ssk, P2) repeat.
 Repeat Row 1-8 until Pattern 5 measures 8”.

Knit 6 rows. In last knit row increase by 1.
 Pattern 6: “Diagonal Weave” (41 sts)
 Set up row: Knit.
 Row 1 (Wrong side): Purl
 Row 2: K1, (sl 1 wyib, K3) repeat.
 Row 3: (P3, sl 1 wyif) repeat to 1 st before marker, P1.
 Row 4: K1, (drop sl-st off needle to front of work, K2, then pick up dropped st and knit it, K1) repeat to 1 st before marker, K 1.
 Row 5: Purl
 Row 6: K5, (sl 1 wyib, K3) repeat.
 Row 7: (P3, sl 1 wyif) repeat to last 5 sts before the marker, P5.
 Row 8: K3, (sl next 2 sts wyib, drop sl-st off needle to front of work, sl same 2 sts back to left hand needle, then pick up dropped stitch and knit it, K3) repeat to last 2 sts before marker, K2.

Knit 6 rows.

Pattern 7: “Little Tent Pattern” (41 sts)
 Set up row: Knit.
 Row 1 (Wrong side): K2, (P5, K3) repeat to last 7 sts before the marker, P5, K2.
 Row 2: K2, (sl 5 sts wyif, K3) repeat to last 7 sts before the marker, sl 5 wyif, K2
 Row 3: Same as Row 1.
 Row 4: K4, (insert needle under loose strand and knit it together with next stitch, K7) Last repeat ends with K4.

Knit 6 rows.

Bind off.

Abbreviations:

K: knit

P: purl

St or sts: stitch/stitches

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

yo: yarn over

ssk: slip next 2 stitches knitwise, one at a time, and then knit them together

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front.

sl: slip

st-st: slipped stitch

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
